Children’s Hospital of Richmond at VCU (CHoR) is a full-service children’s hospital within the VCU Medical Center and is our community’s only full-service children’s hospital. CHoR offers a robust continuum of pediatric services, research and education. CHoR’s continuum of care includes emergency, primary, secondary, advanced tertiary and long-term care. CHoR has 11 locations across Central Virginia and provides over 40 pediatric medical/surgical services.

VCU is the first medical school in Virginia to be awarded an NIH Clinical Translational Science Award (CTSA).

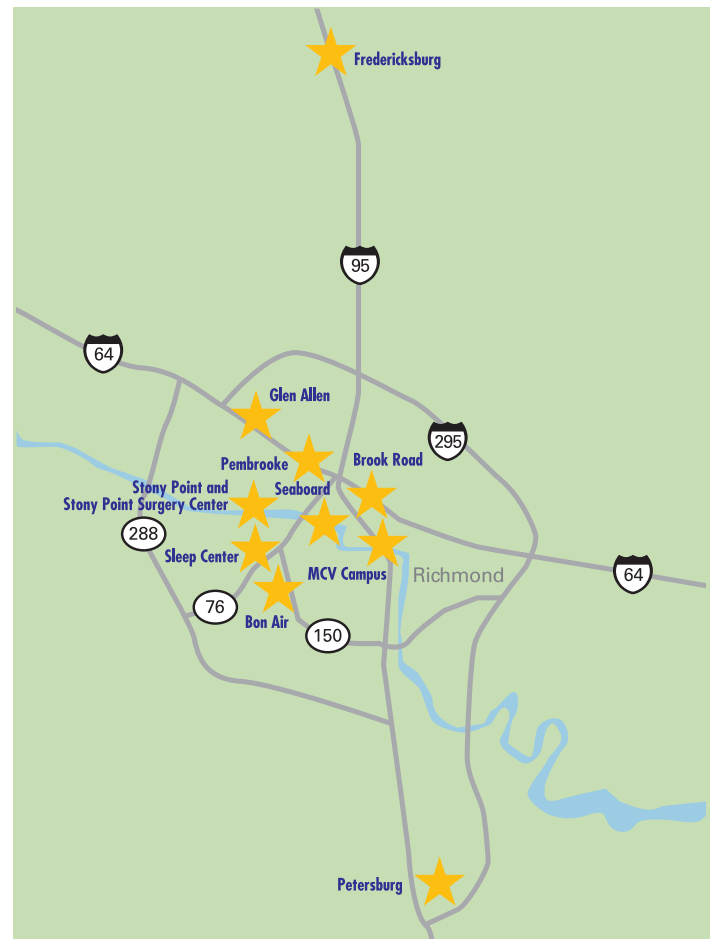

Facilities

Children's Hospital of Richmond at VCU (CHoR) is part of the VCU Medical Center, the only designated Level 1 Trauma



Center in Central Virginia. CHoR has 172 dedicated inpatient pediatric beds and VCU Medical Center offers an additional 40 beds in specialized inpatient units that provide care for both children and adults.

CHoR's child-friendly and family-centered facilities include the only private room Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and the only Level One Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) in Central Virginia. CHoR's Transitional Care Unit is the only specialized care facility that provides pediatric specialized long-term care in Central Virginia.
